STATEMENT OF FAITH



We, as members of the John Wycliffe Christian Education Association, adhere to the following statement of faith. We believe in:

- 1. The unity of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit in the Godhead.
- 2. The sovereignty of God in creation, providence, revelation, redemption and final judgement.
- 3. The divine inspiration and entire trustworthiness of Holy Scripture and its supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.
- 4. The sinfulness and guilt of all men and women since the Fall, rendering them subject to God's wrath and condemnation.
- 5. Redemption from the guilt, penalty and power of sin solely through the sacrificial death, as our representative and substitute, of the Lord Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God.
- 6. The bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ from the dead and His ascension to the right hand of God the Father.



- 7. The necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to make the death of Christ effective to the individual sinner, granting them repentance towards God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 8. The justification of the sinner by the grace of God through faith in Christ alone.
- 9. The one holy universal Church, which is the body of Christ and to which all true believers belong.
- 10. The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Further, we believe that:

- 11. Humankind is subject to either acceptance or rejection of Christ as its absolute ruler, i.e. service of the one true God or service of a God substitute.
- 12. God, as ruler over all creation, redeems those who are united in Christ, renewing them in His image. He restores them to fellowship with Himself by His Word and Spirit.

This statement of faith involves a commitment of life to Jesus Christ by persons believing it. Such a commitment should be demonstrated in quality of life and witness. Affirmed as part of new Constitution of The JWCEA, May, 2012.
